



Nursery Fees from December 2025

Daily rate (8am – 6pm) £79.00

Morning or afternoon (8am -1pm or 1pm -6pm) £40.00

Early drop off (from 7.30am) £4.00

Extra days £82.00

Last minute places available as half days at short notice, up to two weeks in advance (please ask at the office about space available each week) £30.00

- ✿ Our nursery and pre-school is open from 7.30am until 6.00pm weekdays throughout the year.
- ✿ We offer all year-round places, 52 weeks of the year.
- ✿ Our only closures are Christmas day, Boxing day, New Year's Day and two team training days, advertised at least a month in advance.
- ✿ We request a minimum attendance of two days a week.
- ✿ Fees are applicable for the place, not for attendance. Monthly invoices are charged for the child's booking pattern, and all components of the daily rate are chargeable regardless of attendance or nursery closure.
- ✿ All fees (including childcare vouchers) are payable monthly in advance and are due no later than the 27th of each month for the following month.
- ✿ You will be invoiced monthly via our parent admin software system and your invoice will reflect your child's actual booking pattern for the month ahead and as such will change each month.
- ✿ We accept fees via childcare vouchers, the tax-free childcare scheme or bacs transfer.
- ✿ The daily rate of £79.00 is made up of two elements: Booking pattern at £69.00 a day and consumables and extras charges at £10.00 a day.
- ✿ From age 9 months eligible children can access government funding from the Free Early Educational Entitlement (FEEE) scheme. This entitles the child to either 15 or 30 hours a week of free early years education during school term times.
- ✿ The FEEE element of your child's fees will be shown in the booking pattern section of the invoice, the dates and hours will be shown on the invoice as free.
- ✿ The booking pattern element of the daily fee covers the cost of delivering high quality, flexible early education and care.
- ✿ Consumables and extras charges cover the cost of all meals, snacks and drinks during the nursery day, consumable items such as sun cream or items used for personal care and the cost of facilitating enrichment activities such as trips out of nursery or visitors to nursery.
- ✿ Consumables and extras charges are voluntary when the child is accessing FEEE hours. If parents do not wish to pay these charges, they will be required to provide food and other consumables from home and their child will be offered an alternative activity during trips and visits.
